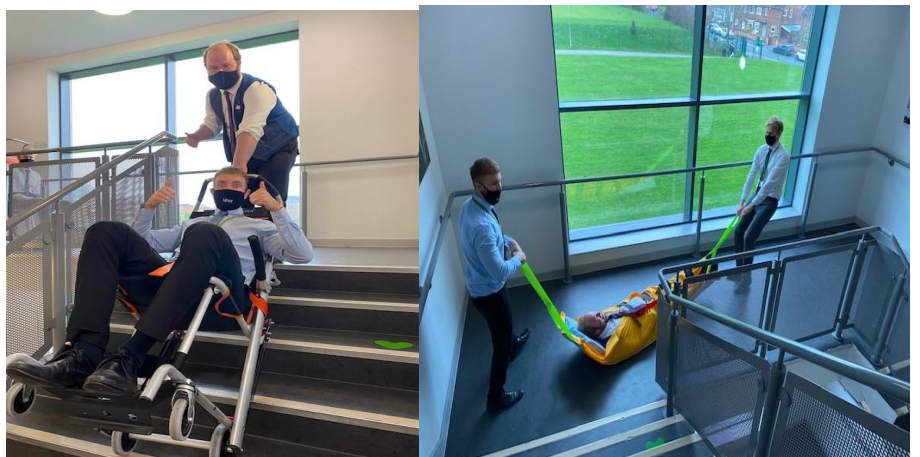

We just wanted to make you aware of a new ERDF program - for SMEs across the greater Nottingham area - to access free support in relation to sustainability.

The Sustainability in Enterprise (SiE) project has the following general goals:

- Support SMEs to adopt and implement growth-enhancing and sustainable processes and technologies.
- Reduction of GHG emissions
- Place graduates into SMEs to act as sustainability champions and improve the knowledge and awareness of sustainability in the local economy with a longer-term related benefit of improving local graduate retention.
- Establish a Business Environmental Network in the region, providing the opportunity to share best practice and raise awareness to the SME community.

This will be achieved through five strands of support available to eligible SMEs:

- Sustainability consultancy
- Sustainable product design
- Carbon reduction workshops
- Sustainability grants
- Graduate placements and the Sustainability Community Lab

The support is free of charge for SMEs within the SUDS area (area checker available at the link below). Organisations need to have less than 250 employees, an annual turnover under EUR 50 million or a yearly balance sheet less than EUR 43 million.
